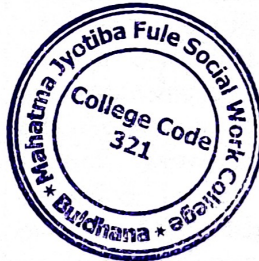

Students suggested to have water	The issue of infrastructure development was discussed with the management.	Students increased time of their stay in college for reading and study gave



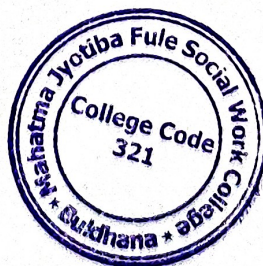

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II. Feedback From Teachers
